PERSONAL GEAR

Bag lunch for Saturday with beverage

\$5 - \$8 for buying fast-food lunch on the way home

Troop 73 Red Hat (worn on Saturday)

Complete B.S.A. Uniform w/neckerchief & belt (worn on Saturday)

Backpack to hold all personal gear

Sleeping Bag for outdoor use - in waterproof bag

Ground Cloth for under tent!!!

Troop 73 Green Tee Shirt(s)

Poncho or "waterproof" raincoat w/hood

Canteen or water bottle for hike

Flashlight w/batteries

Personal First Aid Kit containing:

Band-aids, Antiseptic, moleskin, etc.

Personal Toiletry Kit containing:

Toilet Paper, Toothbrush/Paste, Comb/Brush

Washcloth & Soap, Metal Mirror if desired

Hiking Boots (**need not be worn on Saturday**)

Other Footwear (sneakers)

Personal Mess Kit (plate/bowl(s), utensils, cup/mug)

This checklist with items checked

Changes of underwear

Socks and extra socks

Another complete change of clothes

Sleepwear (sweats if desired)

Medium Jacket for cool evenings/mornings

Day Pack/Knapsack if you have one – *must be brought empty*

PATROL GEAR

Patrol Flag & Leaders with Notebook & pens

Patrol Menu and Duty Roster in zip loc bag

At least two day-packs for carrying lunches/ponchos, socks, etc. on hike

Patrol Camping Gear:

Should be attached to or packed in packs (except pots and water jugs)

Water Jugs Should Be Brought FILLED!

Patrol Cooler & Crate with Food Supplies

**Don't forget the forgettables: garbage bags, matches, seasonings,
paper towel, soap and brillo**

OPTIONAL GEAR

Money for souvenirs

Foam Pad or Thin Air Mattress

Scout knife, Compass, Camera

Boy Scout Handbook and/or Fieldbook
