PERSONAL GEAR – to be brought by each Scout

No Boy Scout uniforms required

Backpack

Lunch, including beverage (warm beverage?)

Sleeping Bag for outdoor use - in waterproof bag

Extra blanket or 2nd sleeping bag to use inside primary sleeping bag

Ground Cloth for under tent!!!

Flashlight w/batteries

Personal Toiletry Kit containing:

Toilet Paper, Toothbrush/Paste, Comb/Brush

Washcloth & Soap, Metal Mirror if desired

Personal First Aid Kit: May include: Band-aids, Antiseptic, pain reliever, moleskin

Poncho or "waterproof" raincoat **w/hood**

Canteen or Water Bottle (filled at home)

Hiking Boots (should be worn at start of trip)

Other Footwear (sneakers)

Personal Mess Kit (plate/bowl(s), utensils, cup/mug)

This checklist with items checked

Layers of clothing for cold weather

Another complete change of clothes including:

Pants, Tee Shirt, Heavier/ Sweat Shirt, Socks, Underwear

Extra Changes of underwear

Socks and extra socks

Sleepwear (sweats if desired, although cotton not best choice)

Heavy Jacket

Warm hat (or 2) and gloves

Foam Pad or ***Thin*** Air Mattress

PATROL GEAR

Most Patrol Gear will be provided to Patrols at campsite

Patrol Crate with supplies

Leaders with Notebook & pens

Patrol Menu and Duty Roster in zip loc bag

Patrol Flag

OPTIONAL GEAR – you bring it you carry it
