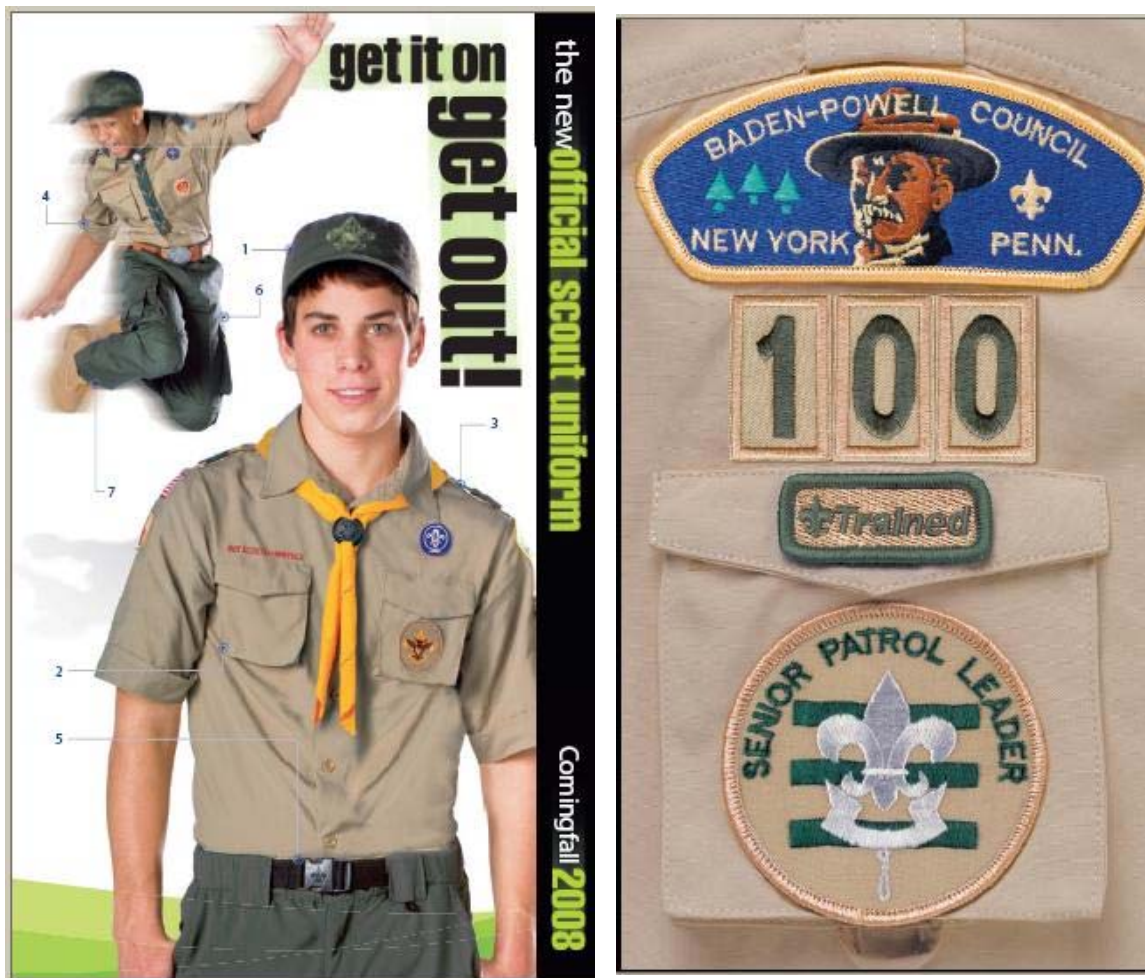


# The *NEW* Boy Scout Centennial Uniform !



It's tougher ! It's cooler ! It's more wearable ! It's more durable !

You may continue to wear your old Boy Scout Uniform for as long as it fits, and as long as it holds together. But as you become ready to purchase a new uniform or uniform parts, the *Centennial Uniform* will be the way to go.

\* New shirt (in cotton or supplex) with three large cargo pockets, green shoulder loops, and American Flag on the right shoulder. You add the purple World Friendship Crest, our Council strip, your rank, and your badge of office. Your badge of office goes ON the new pocket on the left sleeve. The Troop has ordered a combination patch with 7, 3, and 50 Years combined – easier to sew (or glue) on. They'll be here soon. Patrol patches will be coming too!

\* New pants with huge cargo pockets and zip off lower legs. \* GREY colored socks that are great for hiking and super-fast drying. \* And the new Scout belt is wider and tougher. Bigger buckle – probably designed in Texas.

\* Troop 73 is sticking with our Red Troop Hat, and a Scout Committee has formed to explore possible changes to the colors of our Troop neckerchief.
