Each Scout's Personal Gear

Points will be deducted for missing items

Daypack containing the following:

Proper Clothing for the season w/layers

(avoid cotton if possible)

Warm Hat & Gloves

Proper waterproofed winter footwear

NO SNEAKERS

Rain Gear – just in case

Canteen or water bottle (filled at home)

Bag Lunch (no glass bottles if possible)

An extra pair of socks

A non-breakable mug for cocoa/ soup

A spoon to eat soup with if desired

If you want to get all your points for being prepared, make certain that you have everything you need – sooner than the night before. There will be NO wood collection at the Middle School parking lot or at the Klondike.
