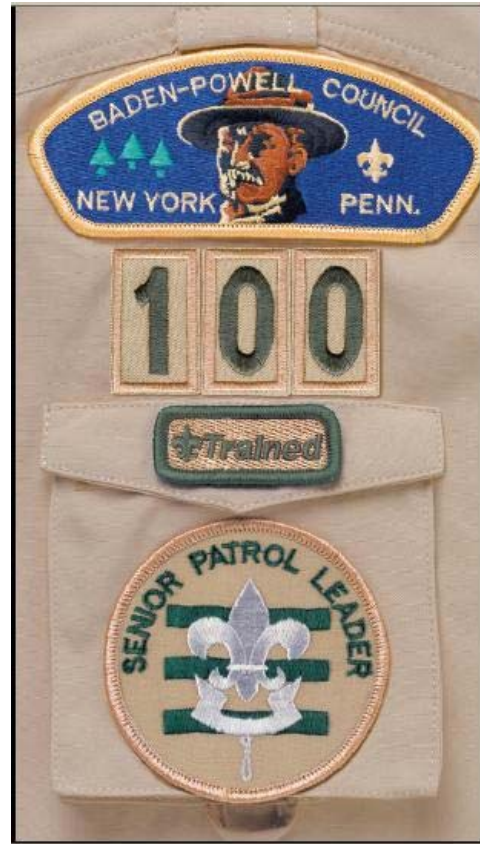
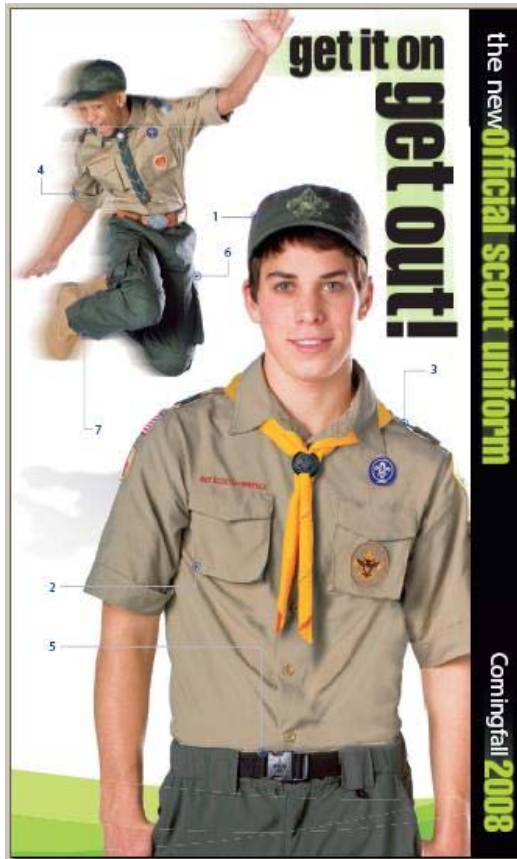


The Troop 73 Uniform Exchange and the Boy Scout Uniform !
