PERSONAL GEAR

No Scout Uniform required

Bag lunch for Saturday with beverage (light)

Poncho or "waterproof" raincoat **w/hood**

Canteen or water bottle

Hiking Boots – need to be worn on Saturday

Troop 73 Red Hat

Backpack (packed with personal and Patrol gear)

Sleeping Bag for outdoor use - in waterproof bag

Ground Cloth for under tent or inside tent!!!

Flashlight w/batteries

Personal First Aid Kit containing:

Band-aids, Antiseptic, moleskin, etc.

Personal Toiletry Kit containing:

Toilet Paper, Toothbrush/Paste, Comb/Brush

Washcloth & Soap, Metal Mirror if desired

Other Footwear (sneakers)

Personal Mess Kit (plate/bowl(s), utensils, cup/mug)

This checklist with items checked

Changes of underwear

Extra socks

Another complete change of clothes

Sleepwear (sweats if desired)

Medium/Heavy Jacket for cool evenings/mornings

Warm Hat for cool evenings/mornings and sleeping

PATROL GEAR

Patrol Flag

Leaders with Notebook & pens

Patrol Menu and Duty Roster in zip loc bag

Patrol Crate or Bin and any and all gear the Patrol was responsible to bring

WATER JUGS SHOULD BE BROUGHT FILLED

Don't forget the *forgettables*:

garbage bags, matches, seasonings, foil, paper towel, soap and scrubber sponge, etc.
